SPEECH SOUND DEVELOPMENT

Articulation refers to the production and clarity of speech sounds.Speech sounds develop gradually from the age of birth to 7 years old. Articulation or speech sound disorders are common amongst children. 
BIRTH - 6 MONTHS

Babies make cooing sounds (e.g., oo, ee, ahh), turn their head towards sounds, and gives eye contact when they hear people talking or making sounds.

6- 12 MONTHS

Babies start to make babbling noises (e.g., daddy badaba, mamama). Babies laugh and cry to get their needs and wants met.
